Our Speakers



Prof. Nadia Khan

Prof Nadia Khan is a Professor and Head of General Internal Medicine at the University of British Columbia. She completed her medical school at the University of Alberta, followed by a General Internal Medicine Fellowship and a Master's in Community Health Sciences at the University of Calgary. A clinician-scientist at the Center for Advancing Health Outcomes in Vancouver, her research focuses on the impact of ethnic and gender disparities in cardiovascular disease risk, health services utilization, and disease management. With over 180 peer-reviewed publications, she has also held the Michael Smith Foundation Career Scientist award in Ethnicity and Chronic Disease Management. Dr. Khan is a general internist at St. Paul's Hospital, Vancouver, and the Director of the SPH Hypertension Clinic.

She serves as Vice President of the Canadian Hypertension Specialist Society and is an American Hypertension Society Clinical Specialist in Hypertension. Dr. Khan was the President of Hypertension Canada (2016-2020) and leads Research and Education at the International Society of Hypertension (2016-2024)

Professor Amjad Parvaiz is a globally recognized colorectal surgeon specializing in laparoscopic and robotic surgery. He earned his MBBS from King Edward Medical University in Lahore and received multiple Fellowships from the Royal College of Surgeons in Glasgow and England. Currently, he heads Laparoscopic & Robotic Colorectal Surgery at the Champalimaud Foundation in Lisbon, Portugal, and serves as a Visiting Consultant and Head of Robotic Surgery at Hamad General Hospital in Qatar. He is also a professor at the University of Portsmouth and an honorary professor at the University of Belgrade.

A pioneer in minimally invasive surgery, Professor Parvaiz has performed over 5,000 laparoscopic and robotic procedures and played a key role in the UK's National Training Programme (Lapco). He founded the European Academy of Robotic Colorectal Surgery (EARCS) and has authored over 200 peer-reviewed publications. His innovations in robotic rectal surgery have made him a leading figure in the field.

He has received numerous awards, including a National Medal for Excellence in Cancer Care, and has trained surgeons worldwide. In addition to his professional achievements, he enjoys sports, mountaineering, and Urdu literature.

Dr. Rao is board certified in both dermatology and dermatopathology and is a leading authority on pigmented lesions, as well as a pioneer in dermoscopy and confocal microscopy. He completed residency training and fellowships at the University of London, University of Texas Southwestern, New York University and Cornell University. Dr. Rao currently serves as the acting chair and a clinical professor of dermatology and dermatopathology in the department of dermatology at Rutgers Robert Wood Johnson Medical School. Dr. Rao is also an associate clinical professor of dermatology at Weill Cornell Medical College at Cornell University.

Dr. M. Jamil Akhtar is a Clinical Assistant Professor at the University of British Columbia (UBC) and an experienced Anesthesiologist at the University Hospital of Northern British Columbia. He earned his medical degree from Rawalpindi Medical College and completed his residency in

Anesthesiology at the University of Witwatersrand in South Africa. With over 15 years of teaching experience at UBC/UNBC, Dr. Akhtar has held leadership roles, including Discipline-Specific Site Lead and Chair of the Quality Assurance Committee at UBC, and is a Physician Quality Improvement (PQI) Champion.

Dr. Akhtar is dedicated to enhancing patient care and healthcare systems, with expertise in quality improvement and strategic leadership. He has contributed to provincial healthcare initiatives as a member of the QI Steering Committee of Doctors of BC and as PQI Adviser for Northern Health. His commitment extends globally through his work with APPNA, where he is an active member and leader, contributing to healthcare advocacy and development.

In addition to his medical work, Dr. Akhtar is passionate about improving healthcare access in underserved communities, particularly through APPNA's philanthropic initiatives. Outside of his professional life, he enjoys golfing in British Columbia, balancing his work with a relaxed and active lifestyle

Dr Natasha Afzal

Dr. Afzal completed her psychiatric training in Ireland and has been practicing as an adult and rehabilitation psychiatrist in British Columbia for over 15 years. She has served in a range of consulting roles across Fraser Health and the First Nations Health Authority, where she continues to support complex patient populations and interdisciplinary teams. In addition to her clinical work, she holds a faculty appointment with the Department of Psychiatry at the University of British Columbia.

Dr. Afzal has been involved in initiatives aimed at improving physician health and wellness. She is a strong proponent of collaborative care models and advocates for the active involvement of service users and families in shaping mental health services. Her clinical and academic interests include rehabilitation and recovery in severe and persistent mental illness, treatment-resistant psychosis, early intervention in psychotic disorders, as well as physician health and wellness.

Dr. Rasoul Sotoudehmanesh is a distinguished gastroenterologist with over two decades of clinical, academic, and research experience in Iran and Canada. He currently serves as a gastroenterologist and Assistant Professor at the University Hospital of Northern British Columbia (UHNBC), affiliated with the University of British Columbia.

Dr. Sotoudehmanesh previously held a professorship at Tehran University of Medical Sciences, where he led clinical research and education in gastroenterology. He was the Director of the Advanced Therapeutic GI Fellowship Program at TUMS for nearly a decade, mentoring numerous fellows and contributing to capacity-building in digestive health. His areas of expertise include endoscopic ultrasound (EUS), pancreatobiliary disorders, and inflammatory bowel disease. He has authored more than 45 peer-reviewed publications, including studies in *The Lancet*, *Endoscopy*, *Pancreas*, and *American Journal of Gastroenterology*.
